

# COMPUTING in MODEL SCHOOLS - PEDAGOGY MODEL

## Teachers facilitate learning by...

### Teacher Model



Teacher Model - The teacher demonstrates by thinking aloud how something is done/ the processes used - students participate by actively attending to the demonstration. Usually followed by students trying out new learning on their own in a supported context.

### Teacher Sharing



Teacher Sharing - The teacher provides the direction and invites students to contribute - students contribute ideas and information. Decision making is negotiated between student and teacher resulting in a jointly developed outcome. Usually followed by students trying out new learning on their own in a supported context.

### Teacher Guide



Teacher Guide - The teacher scaffolds help and provides support and corrective feedback - students do the work with help from the teacher or other sources at predetermined points in the learning activity.

## Employing a range of Student Centered Teaching Practices

### Teacher Facilitator



### Teacher Coach



Teacher Coach - The teacher offers individual support and encouragement as necessary - students work independently, and are in control of the ideas, the information flow and the outcome

### Teacher Collaborator



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Teacher Collaborator - Teachers work together to plan, teach, monitor, assess and report on student progress. Includes shared daily lesson preparation; shared selection of collaborative protocols and practices, distributed leadership and responsibilities and shared professional learning/ learning together
